SUBJECT: Update on highway, footpath & other matters since 15/9/16

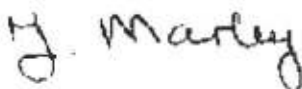
1. Items raised at previous council meetings:-

The following were reported to Highways after the September meeting but no updates yet from NYCC:-

1. Three locations of excess grit/gravel at road side which is dangerous to motorists and in particular cyclists:-
 - Hay Lane junction/bend with Scalby Nabs road
 - Hay Lane junction with Church Hill, Scalby
 - Barmoor Lane/North Street junction at Foulseyke Pond
2. A number of deep potholes
 - Hay Lane between junction with road to Scalby Nabs and the 30mph speed signs
 - Hackness Drive and Hackness Gardens
3. Surface breaking up/uneven & dangerous to pedestrians
 - footway Hackness Road Scalby at house numbers 30, 52, 81 and 84 and also a couple of yards the Hackness side of the bridge over the sea cut (allotments)
4. Ginnel from side of 546 Scalby Road to Barmoor Close - overhanging hedge requires cutting back as footway is restricted.

2. New items

1. Christmas Tree at Newlands shops will be slightly smaller than previous years (17 feet instead of 20 feet) as SBC have had difficulty sourcing trees of sufficient height. Total cost (including putting up/removal and lighting) likely to be in region of £375.
