1. Items raised at previous council meetings:-

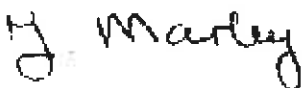
1. Repainting of central filter lane on A171 Scalby road at its northern junction with Wreyfield Drive - reported to NYCC 15/2/17

2. New items

2. All councillors on email contacted 15/2/17 to make them aware the problem of glass around play equipment at Linden Road playground continues & to ask those going through the area to monitor.
3. Parking in vicinity of The Green - some minor problems recurring, some of which appear to be caused by residents. Chairman monitoring.

3. Library update
