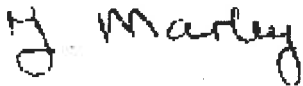
SUBJECT: Update on highway, footpath & other matters since 14/12/17

1. Items raised at previous council meetings:-

1. Ongoing problems with filter arrow on traffic lights at junction of Burniston Road and Cross Lane again referred (via Parish Portal) to NYCC Highways.
2. Blocked gullies Scalby Road near pedestrian crossing opposite library (first reported 29/11/17) - still unresolved although on 13/12/17 NYCC confirmed an order had been raised for the gullies to be cleaned out.
3. Traffic lights - Problem with red light not working for traffic exiting Coldyhill Lane onto Scalby Road. Reported 8/12 (via Parish Portal) and 22/12 via email. Repair finally done just before Christmas.

2. New items

1. Failed temporary traffic lights at water main burst Hay Lane/Wordsworth Close junction. Reported 30/12/17 by Chairman to Yorkshire Water. Repairs carried out 31/12/17.
2. Various faulty streetlights reported to NYCC via Parish Portal.
