SUBJECT: Update on highway, footpath & other matters since 13/11/19

1. Items raised at previous council meetings:-

1. Newby Primary School - problem with the flooding at the bottom of the ginnel from Scalby Road – rain for much of the three days 27-29 November – some minor puddles on pavement but no sign of flooding. Will continue to monitor.

2. New items

2. Missing junction sign Barmoor Lane/High Barmoor. Reported to Area 3 13/11/19.
3. Added to parish caretaker's list of work:-
 - A. Dirty signs at junction Coldyhill Lane/Scalby Road, Green Lane/Greenstead Road corner, Green Lane near St. Mark's, Green Lane/Colescliffe Road corner, Newlands Park Drive/Crescent corner, A165 both side near Scalby Manor, Scalby Rd end of Green Lane (school sign), Barmoor Lane (Scalby Rd side of ford) duck sign
 - B. Epicormic growth/minor pruning to trees at Scalby Beck Road/Scalby Road corner, Coldyhill Lane/Scalby Road corner, near 110 Coldyhill Lane, Green Lane/Coldyhill Lane corner, Green Lane/Scalby Road corner, Colescliffe Road/Green Lane corner, Lady Edith's Park (Scalby Road end), Barmoor Lane.
4. Various items have been removed from parish caretaker's list of work including cutting back and tidying around bus stop on Scalby Road opposite Rosette, highway signs washed and epicormic growth cut back at several locations.
5. Overhanging hedge (believed North Cliff Golf Club) on path to Cross Lane when leaving Cinder Track at Coldyhill Lane bridge – picture taken 15/11/19 by Cllr. Towse and reported to SBC (landowner) 18/11/19.
6. Complaints re. sale of Christmas trees on verge near Rosette – passed to Area3 Highways 28/11/19
7. Rural verges cut right back to field hedge on Lady Edith's Drive/Low Road, Red Scar Lane, Scalby Road and Barmoor Lane in order to remove bracken/gorse/hawthorn.
8. Restricted visibility at junction West Park Road/Station Road due to overhanging hedge – pictures taken and reported to Area 3 27/11/19.
