TOILETS - AN ESSENTIAL AMENITY

We all need them—now the Sweet Pea Committee needs people to help them keep open the public toilets in Scalby.

Back in 2005 Scarborough Borough Council closed the public toilets in Scalby High Street. This resulted in "desperate" people using resident's gardens and St Laurence's Church grounds as toilets. Following a successful campaign, the Scalby Toilets Trust was formed and the toilets re-opened in October 2007. On opening day, a bunch of sweet peas was placed in the ladies toilets, hence why we are now affectionately known as the Sweet Pea Committee.

The Trust's Chairman - Pete Afford - says "Over the years, we have received fabulous financial support from both the Parish Council and the Borough Council, together with local organisations such as Scalby Fair, and a wide range of businesses and private donations. Thank you for all your help. However time has gone by and none of us are getting any younger. Some of the trustees would now like to step down, so we need help to continue the work of keeping the toilets open.



Contractors clean the toilets but other jobs (such as opening and closing the toilets each day and collecting and banking the money) is done by the trustees.

We're looking for a few people to join the Scalby Toilet Trust as trustees and help us to ensure this essential amenity remains open. The Trust meets 4 times a year.

We also need new photographs of Scalby & area for our successful calendar which we sell in order to raise funds to keep the toilets open. All offerings are gratefully received. Please take to Liz at the Yew Tree Café in Scalby High Street and your photograph could appear in our 2015 calendar."
