DON'T IGNORE IT REPORT IT



Newby and Scalby Parish Council and North Yorkshire Police are holding a "**Police Day**" on **Wednesday 21st October** to raise awareness of the arrival of dark evenings and the opportunities this can provide the criminally minded.

From **10am to 12noon** Police Officers and Councillors will be **at Newlands Shops** then between **12noon and 2pm at Proudfoots Supermarket** car park to give crime prevention advice and distribute leaflets and light timers to the elderly and vulnerable.

We will soon be celebrating Hallowe'en and Bonfire Night and ask everyone taking part to enjoy themselves but please - consider your neighbours and in particular the risk and fear to the young, elderly and animals.

Due to concerns that incidents within the parish are not being reported to the Police, the Council is offering an **alternative way to report things** to the Police. From 21st October we're providing **secure letter boxes at various shops in the area**, so you can also report anything you feel the Police should be aware of by completing one of our forms. It can be a parking issue, burglary, theft or suspicious incident or anything you feel they should be aware of.

The best advice is, **don't ignore it, report it.**

Simply go to one of the places below, write brief details on the forms provided and put your completed form in the small letter boxes provided. The boxes are emptied by the Police.
NOTE: these secure letter boxes are an extra service and do **NOT** replace the Police's 101 contact number.
