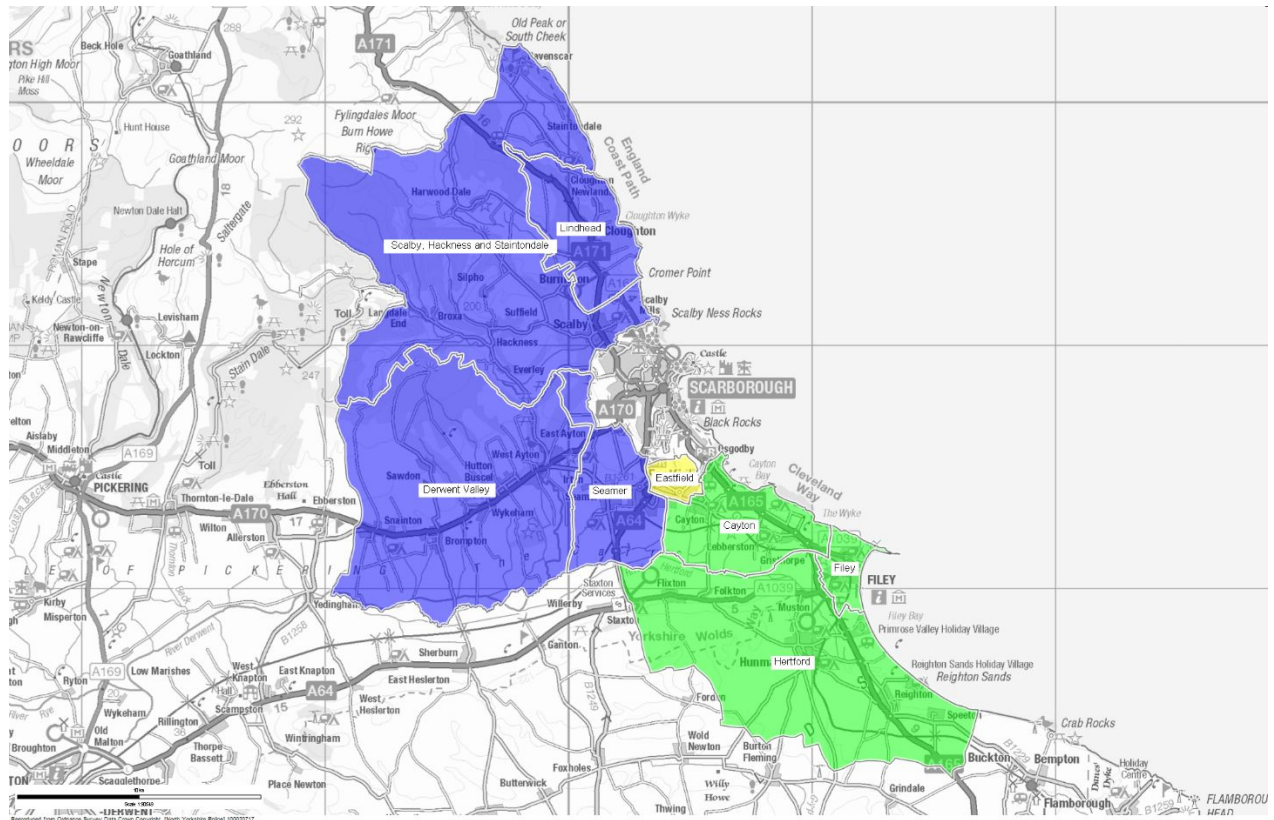

Which areas are covered from Filey and Eastfield Police Stations?

The areas in blue and yellow – covered from Eastfield Police station. Areas in green – covered from Filey Police Station.



There were 57 incidents reported in your area during December. Incidents of note are as follows: -

03/12/2024 13:05 – During November, significant damage has been caused to a scheduled monument by 4x4 off-road vehicles and motorbikes in the forestry. Approximately £50,000 of damage to the scheduled monument is likely to have occurred on several occasions whereby the vehicles/bikes have ridden over and through it causing contamination and damage to archaeological deposits. Damage has also been caused to the visual significance of the monument. The impact on the heritage value of this location cannot be compensated. This matter is under investigation with crime reference number 12240220658, please continue to report any information on off-road 4x4 or motor bikes using the forestry paths.

07/12/24 & 08/12/24 – There was widespread disruption across the roads throughout the weekend. Multiple trees succumbed to the wind, blocking roads in the process. A recovery truck attended one location to pick a car up that had struck a fallen tree, a tree then fell down on the access route which blocked the recovery truck in.

15/12/2024 09:21 – Several reports of off-road motor bikes were received throughout the day. The first report of the day came from Cloughton where 10 were seen to ride off the A171 and allegedly onto private fields.

15/12/2024 12:00 – A report of 10 unregistered off-road motorbikes heading up into the forestry from A170 at Wykeham. Officers are aware of these ongoing issues and patrolling the area

whenever they can. Thank you to everyone who is taking the time to make reports, it is helping us map out the regular locations and direct resources to the correct areas.

15/12/2024 12:15 – A report was received from High Langdale in the Forestry of 9 off-road motor bikes heading past the scout camp. Officers managed to stop 3 of the bikes near Scalby and 2 more of them further down the A171. One of the bikers was given a document to provide proof that he had insurance for the bike, if he doesn't within 14 days then he will be prosecuted for no insurance. Another had no road tax but logged on to the DVLA website and taxed it at the road side.

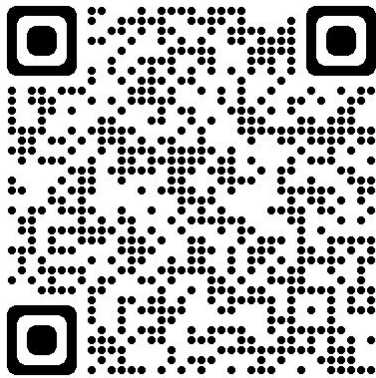
